INSTALLATION

- **Before You connect the power cord to the device please check fuses value and make sure that the voltage switch setting reflects the correct local power line voltage. For line voltages from 100V to 120V, set the switch to 115V and use 1,25A fuses (slo-blo; 5x20mm). The 230V position is good for all line voltages from 200-240Volts; fuses: 630mA (slo-blo; 5x20mm).**
- This unit is equipped with a three-pronged AC power cord. To reduce the risk of electrical shock never remove or otherwise attempt to defeat the ground pin of the power cord.
- Do not allow water to enter this unit or allow the unit to become wet. Fire or electrical shock may result.
- Do not place a container with liquid or small metal objects on top of this unit. Liquid or metal objects inside this unit are a fire and electrical shock hazard.
- Do not place heavy objects, including this unit, on top of the power cord. A damaged power cord is a fire and electrical shock hazard.

OPERATION

- Do not scratch, bend, twist, pull, or heat the power cord. A damaged power cord is a fire and electrical shock hazard.
- Do not remove the unit's cover. You could receive an electrical shock. If you think internal inspection, maintenance, or repair is necessary, contact your dealer or producer.

- Keep this unit away from the following locations:

FOR CORRECT OPERATION

CONNECTOR PIN ASSIGNMENTS

- XLR connectors (INPUT, OUTPUT) are wired according to the AES standard : Pin 1 = shield, Pin 2 = hot (+), Pin 3= cold (-).
- ¼" TRS connectors (EXTERNAL SIDECHAIN) are wired according to the AES standard: tip = hot (+), ring= cold (-), slave = shield

INFLUENCE ON CELL PHONE USAGE

Using a cell phone (mobile telephone) near this unit may induce noise. If noise occurs, use the telephone away from the unit.

REPLACING ABRASIVE PARTS AND CLEANING THE UNIT

The performance of components with moving contacts, such as toggle switches, rotary switches and connectors, deteriorates over time. The rate of deterioration depends on the operating environment and is unavoidable. Consult your dealer or producer about replacing defective components. Clean this unit only with lint-free damp cloth and do not use cleaning agents.

DESIGN

The GEM AUDIO LABS *Preceptor* is a two channel (stereo/ dual mono) pure analog (Class-A, discrete) dynamic processor, in which the gain reduction is made by a discrete VCA based on bipolar transistors and Zener diodes. In fact, there are two independent mono blocks sharing common enclosure, ON/OFF switch and LINK/DUAL MONO switch.

ENCLOSURE

Preceptor's enclosure is a solid (3U high) and compact construction based on aluminum and steel. It has been designed according to EIA 19" standard. For enclosure painting the best coating powders have been used (scratches and cracks resistant). Such a solid design reduces the risk of any mechanical damages, and lets you enjoy the trouble-free device not only working for the warranty period.

POWER SUPPLY SECTION

Special care has gone into the design of the power supply of the *Preceptor* because the power supply is the heart of any electronic system, and the better it is, the better the whole system works. In an audio system, this translates into a better sound quality, lower noise and unwanted distortion elimination.

Preceptor's power supply is based on a 70VA toroidal transformer, which is made on our special order from properly selected cores. It is characterized by the highest quality, good supply of power, silent operation and excellent electrical parameters. It has the core and windings impregnation, electrical shielding (between windings) and magnetic (external screen), its center is flooded with resin. The transformer has an anti-vibration mount.

Primary voltage can be switched between 230V~50 Hz and 115V~60 Hz via the switch located on the rear panel.

The device is connected to the line by a standard 3 core cord with an IEC plug.

There are two safety fuses located in the mains input socket on the rear panel:

- 630mA (slo-blo; 5x20mm) for 230V~50 Hz
- 1,25A (slo-blo; 5x20mm) for 115V~60 Hz.

On the primary side of the transformer a special EMI filter is installed. It filters out any interferences that may enter the device from the electric network. The signal sections are separated from the power supply section by solid metal partitions.

Every channel has its own rectifiers and secondary voltages stabilizers. We have designed a special filtering stage with high capacity capacitors (10000 μ F) and special active filters (based on discrete elements) eliminating noise and ripple. Power of all stages is symmetrical and every section has its own stabilization, which keeps the voltage range of +/- 0.01V. All the voltage stabilizers are mounted to a common heat sink, which cools them evenly. Furthermore, the heat sink acts as an additional shield.

Operational voltages:

First gain stage : +/- 20V,

Sidechain: +/- 20V,

Blender: +/- 18V,

Make up gain stage: +/- 28V,

Lights and relays : 12V.

ROTARY AND TOGGLE SWITCHES

Preceptor has only rotary and toggle switches installed to obtain the best repeatability of all settings. Thus you can easily return to your favorite settings. By using 1% low-noise metalized resistors and gold contact rotary switches, we succeeded to obtain (in the link mode) the difference between levels and characteristics of two channels in a range of +/- 0.1 dB.

SIGNAL PATH AND SIDECCHAIN SECTION

The *Preceptor* has installed a high performance, no compromise, professional input transformers made by Carnhill Transformers Ltd. All elements in the signal path and the sidechain section are built from the high quality discrete elements (low-noise transistors, ultra low-impedance electrolytic capacitors, precision film capacitors, precision silver-mica capacitors, 1% low noise metalized resistors, etc.) Only in the blend section were used transparent IC's for uncompressed (DRY) and compressed (WET) signals mixing.

The gain reduction is made by a discrete VCA based on bipolar transistors and Zener diodes. There are 16 Zener diodes, of course manually selected and matched.

THE FRONT PANEL CONTROLS AND THEIR USE



A POWER

Common POWER on/off switch. The amber light and panel meters will glow when the unit is powered on. Please turn down the volume of your studio monitors before turning on or turning off the *Preceptor*.

B BYPASS/IN

The bypass is a hard relay bypass. If the unit loses power, it will default to this hard relay bypass. BYPASS- hard bypass is activated (panel meter is highlighted in orange). IN- the signal is going through the unit (panel meter is highlighted in yellow)

C INPUT GAIN


This switch lets You choose between HIGH or LOW input gains by changing input Z (HIGH- 2k5Ω, LOW- 10KΩ)

D SIDECCHAIN

In the INT mode the *Preceptor* acts as a normal compressor sending main INPUT signal to the gain reduction stage. In the EXT position You can use another audio track (sending it to the EXT SIDECCHAIN input on the rear panel) to control the volume of the main INPUT signal.


If you want for example to control the volume of the synthesizer pad by the rhythm of a kick, send kick's track to the EXT SIDECCHAIN input and then send pads to the main INPUT. After that activate the EXT mode and set proper volumes of two tracks to obtain expected gain reduction.

The wiring diagram:




Very interesting sound effects can be achieved by doubling the same signal in the INPUT and in the EXT SIDECHAIN input with series equalizer connection. When You increase the level of selected frequencies, the *Preceptor* will react compressing them more than other frequencies and vice versa, when You decrease the level of selected frequencies, the *Preceptor* will not compress them. This technique can really improve the quality of your music. Keep experimenting!

TOTAL HARMONIC DISTORTION FUNCTION (THD)

There is another trick in the box. If the SIDECHAIN switch is in the EXT position and the EXT SIDECHAIN input does not receive any signal, then the *Preceptor* turns into a pleasant harmonic distortion generator. The amount of distortion depends on the Z and the INPUT switches settings. The larger the signal, the more distortion is in the processed signal (at extreme settings, it may be up to several % of THD). This is because there is no control signal and the circuit is driven.

E LIMIT/COMP

In the COMP position the *Preceptor* operates as a compressor with 2:1 compression ratio. In the limit mode its behavior can be compared to the famous Fairchild 660 limiter.

F SPEED

This switch allows to choose between three attack and release speed modes:

“F” - fast mode,

“M” - medium mode

“S” - slow mode.

Depending on the processed signal and the aural effect you want to obtain, you should choose speed mode at your own decision.

G ATTACK

The ATTACK control (11-position gold contact switch) determines how fast the compressor reacts.

Positions “1” (the fastest) to “10” (the slowest).

Position “11” is an additional auto mode (log curve)

H RELEASE

The RELEASE control (11-position gold contact switch) determines the time the compressor needs to get back to the initial value after a level reduction.

Positions from “1” (the fastest) to “10” (the slowest)

Positions “11” is an additional auto mode (log curve)

The following table lists all attack and release times depending on the SPEED mode, the ATTACK and the RELEASE settings.

I INPUT

This is a 11-position gold contact audio taper switch that determines the level of the signal entering the channel, as well as the threshold.

J OUTPUT

21-position gold contact switch set for +10dB/-10dB of gain control. Once the desired amount of limiting or compression is achieved with the use of the INPUT control and the IN-GAIN control, the OUTPUT control can be used to make up any gain lost due to gain reduction. This control is used to set the amount of compressed (WET) signal in the blender stage.

K BLEND

11-position gold contact switch allows to mix compressed (WET) and uncompressed (DRY) signals using only one knob. A single move changes mixing ratio by 10%. This technique is known as parallel compression, or as New York compression. This technique usually needs external mixing console, but not when You use our powerful *Preceptor*.

L S-CHAIN HPF


With this control (5-position gold contact switch) you can remove low frequency information in the sidechain circuit from 40 Hz, 80 Hz, 120 Hz, 200 Hz, 320 Hz. It can be also turned off by setting OFF position.

M LINK/DUAL MONO

When set to the up (LINK) position, the two channels of the *Preceptor* act as a single stereo compressor, with equal gain reduction on both sides, even when there is transient activity only on one channel. You only need to set all the functions on the left and right channel in the same position. It is not a problem having only rotary and toggle switches installed in the unit. In the down (DUAL MONO) position, the *Preceptor* operates as two separate compressors, with the two channels operating completely independently of one another.

It is recommended to use the device in the LINK mode in the case of processing stereo signals.

THE REAR PANEL



a VOLTAGE SWITCH

Make sure that the voltage switch setting reflects the correct local power line voltage. For line voltages from 100V to 120V, set the switch to 115V. The 230V position is good for all line voltages from 200-240Volts.

b MAINS INPUT / AC FUSES HOLDER

The mains AC connector is a standard IEC-type 3 pin connector with a AC fuses (2 pieces) holder. The ground of this AC connector is permanently internally connected to the chassis of the *Preceptor* for safety. It is important to change the fuse before changing the supply voltage:

- 630mA (slo-blo; 5x20mm) for 230V~50 Hz
- 1,25A (slo-blo; 5x20mm) for 115V~60 Hz.

c INPUT

Balanced input XLR wired according to the AES standard : Pin 1 = shield, Pin 2 = hot (+), Pin 3= cold (-). In order to avoid hum, it is recommended to use the device only in balanced connections.


d OUTPUT

Balanced output XLR wired according to the AES standard : Pin 1 = shield, Pin 2 = hot (+), Pin 3= cold (-). In order to avoid hum, it is recommended to use the device only in balanced connections.

e EXT SIDECHAIN

External sidechain input. 1/4" TRS connector wired according to the AES standard: tip = hot (+), ring= cold (-), slave = shield
